Mr. Brown stated in his past experience, it was probably twelve (12) to fifteen (15) minutes. Mr. Brown said occasionally an officer had to run down to South Madison, and it is a twenty (20) minute ride from Ford Road to North Madison. Chief Hager said he will have to sample emergency response times and non-emergency times. He will try to get some averages for the Board.
